General Description

The Living Bridge Media assistant works indirectly with this program, and with other supporting programs to ensure they meet our stringent standard of excellence.

Core Job Functions

Living Bridge Media Department, Quality Control (45%)

- Checking the daily Insight for Living program for quality and accuracy including any and all customizations against the scripts
- Checking the weekend Insight for Living program for quality and accuracy including any and all customizations against the scripts
- Checking short features and special programs for quality and accuracy
- Checking podcast metadata for quality and accuracy
- Monitor partner radio stations websites and audio streams for quality and accuracy
- Proofreading promotional material, checking for quality and accuracy as needed
- Administrating and distributing to staff documents such as quality control forms, script-tracking forms, broadcast scripting overview forms, broadcast schedules, etc.
- Distributing audio files as needed
- Transcoding audio files as needed
- Edits/re-writes announcer script copy as needed
- Communicates script changes to Living Bridge Media team as needed
- Assisting the Living Bridge Media team with ongoing projects as needed

Living Bridge Media Department, Administration (45%)

- Prepares radio station and listener correspondence when appropriate
- Handles filing of station communications as necessary
- Assists in fielding calls and inquiries from stations and Listener Ministries related to the IFLC and Paws & Tales broadcasts
- Collects and organizes monthly invoices
- Maintains LBM production calendar
- Codes department invoices for approval
- Orders office supplies, including printed materials as required
- Maintains department files
- Filing of scripts for ads/tags recorded
- Documents department procedures
- Assists with the updating and organization of physical media storage files
- Produces individual station reports as needed
- Produces monthly station reports and provides analysis
- Performing spot checks on Canadian paid stations (website checks, stream/audio checks, etc.)
- Checking CRTC for any news regarding broadcast policy or partner stations
