Daniel's example of integrity shines brightly against a backdrop of spiritual and political corruption in ancient Babylon. And he serves as a model for us today.

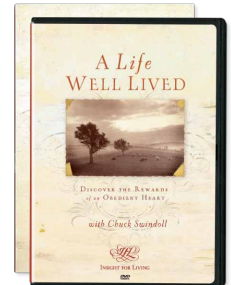


Starting Your Journey

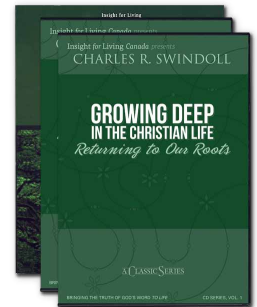

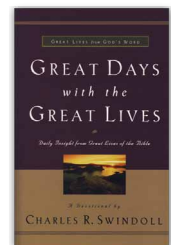
